

Dublinshire Tour

White Trail 

Length: 3.84 miles

Terrain: Fairly flat; trail follows and crosses several streets

Make sure to bring: A butterfly identification guide

This adventure takes you through peaceful Dublin neighborhoods and past parks busy with the excitement of baseball, soccer and other sports. Start near the Dublin Community Pool North at Earlington Park, 5660 Dublinshire Drive. The park has a fishing pond, Little League diamonds, and multi-purpose play fields. Take the trail east on Dublinshire Drive; cross the street and ride south through the wide green spaces along Earlington Parkway. Cross the street and continue riding west along Sells Mill Drive, then north to enter Scottish Corners Park, 5950 Sells Mill Drive. Make sure to stop to enjoy the butterfly garden or — if you've got the energy — work out on the five par stations. Or, just rest in the shade of the shelter house or take a turn on the swings. Then, hit the trails again as you travel north on the bike path through the woods. Turn west at the first bike path junction, then turn north on Muirfield Drive to access the tunnel at Dublinshire and Muirfield drives. Keep going west and you'll hit Dublinshire Drive again. Cross the street and continue south on Wynford Drive. Soon you'll cross Avery Road to gain access to Wyndham Park. Take care in this area, as traffic can be heavy at times. On Avery Road, you'll encounter Avery Park, home of the Art in Public Places Project "Out of Bounds," as well as baseball and softball diamonds, tennis and basketball courts, multi-purpose fields, a tot lot, restrooms, shelters, a drinking fountain and an interior loop bike path, which you can use to return to Wynford Drive. As you proceed south back through Wyndham Park, stop to enjoy the view along the park's two fishing ponds. Then, cross Wynford Drive to access the Dublinshire Greenway path and return to Muirfield Drive. Ride north back to the tunnel at Dublinshire Drive, and follow Dublinshire back to the start of the tour!
