

Park Triad Tour

Yellow Trail 

Length: 5.22 miles, round trip

Terrain: Fairly flat and scenic; very few street intersections

Make sure to bring: A disposable camera for wetland pictures, bottled water and a snack

This tour begins at the Dublin Municipal Building (5200 Emerald Parkway) in one of the City's largest parks, Coffman Park. The bike trail meanders westward past playgrounds, basketball courts and tennis courts, then curves north past the Coffman Park Pavilion to the Dublin Community Recreation Center. Now the trail gets more scenic, following the south fork of Indian Run Creek. Eventually, this trail takes you through Conquistador Court to Indian Run Meadows, where a specialty garden, playground and central pond area await you. Stay on the path along Indian Run Creek until you reach the Muirfield Drive Bike tunnel, which connects Indian Run Meadows to the M.L. "Red" Trabue Nature Reserve. This peaceful wetlands area is home to a wide variety of wildlife, water fowl and plant life. Make sure you park your bikes and take a walk out onto the boardwalk-style fishing pier! If you've brought your fishing pole, cast your line into the pond and enjoy the scenery. And don't forget to explore Trabue's sensory garden and restored log cabin!
